4. Principal's report

- Words Matter Campaign (Harmony movement) chosen as a pilot school, getting to try the
 program for free. About proactively teaching kids to use positive language, something the school
 has made a lot of progress on.

- Safety plans being updated the church that was meant to be the emergency meeting spot is now too small, so Limestone would need to provide buses to keep students warm.
